- 2 school first aid kits will be taken on camp and positioned for all to see.
- A fire drill will be conducted upon arrival and the muster point highlighted. Evacuation and safety procedures will be also highlighted.
- One member of staff has a bronze certificate and one member has a current Senior First Aid certificate.
- A staff car will be on site in case of an emergency.
- Parents have been informed of emergency contact numbers, liability for loss or damage to student/camp property and medical costs incurred in case of an emergency.
- All students will be wearing approved life jackets while canoeing – water only 1.2m deep. Appropriate supervision and communication strategies will be in place.(Staff/student no's, identification, vests, demarcation areas etc)
- Enclosed shoes to be worn for all activities
- Attached are copies of camp protocols, licences, public liability and evacuation procedures.
